Out of the mouths of ... From time to time I am stopped in my tracks by the "down to earth" insights my own children express in relation to Asperger's Syndrome. Recently my 12 yr old son compared his childhood experience with an Asperger father to that of the concept of the "Hole in the Wall" Game Show. In this game, if the contestants are able to contort their bodies to match the shape in the wall and manoeuvre through the hole as the wall passes over them, they avoid ending up in the plunge pool. My son summarised with "Mum eventually got a cramp ... and I couldn't hold my handstand for long enough". (Carol Grigg).
